### Day 1 Monday, June 17, 2024

Depart via scheduled air service from LAX to Paris, France

### Day 2 Tuesday, June 18 Paris / Rouen / Caen (D)

Arrive in Paris

Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach

Transfer to Caen via Rouen

Excursion to Rouen to see the Cathedral. In the Place de la Cathédrale stands the Gothic Cathedral of Notre-Dame, one of the largest and most magnificent in France. The most striking feature is the elaborately articulated west front which was several times painted by Claude Monet. Also see the sight of Joan of Arcs execution

Continue to Caen for late afternoon hotel check-in

Welcome Dinner included, and overnight

As the capital of Lower Normandy, Caen is a thriving university city with exceptional historical heritage. William the Conqueror lent the town his favor in the 11th century and commissioned many of the city's most famous sites including the Abbey aux Hommes and the Abbey aux Dames, where his wife Mathilde is buried. Caen was the center of some of the fiercest fighting in the Liberation of 1944. The peace memorial is unquestionably the greatest museum of World War II and a "must-see" for anyone who visits the city

### Day 3 Wednesday, June 19 Normandy / Caen (B)

Breakfast at the hotel

Morning visit and tour to the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial and the D-Day beaches – sites of the June 6<sup>th</sup>, 1944 Normandy Invasion. White marble crosses and Stars of David stretch off in seemingly endless rows at the Normandy American Cemetery, situated on a now-serene bluff overlooking the bitterly contested sands of Omaha Beach. Also visit and explore the visitor's center

# 10:30am Wreath Laying Ceremony and recital at the Normandy American Cemetery\*

Lunch, on own

Performance at D-Day Museum Plaza in Normandy as part of the American Celebration of Music in France\*

Afternoon visit to the Musée du Débarquement D-Day Memorial Museum in Caen. Explore and learn the historic facts and planning that went into the largest amphibious invasion in history

Dinner on own, and overnight

### Day 4 Thursday, June 20 Paris (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out Morning transfer to Paris

Afternoon guided tour of *Paris historique*. See the most historic parts of the city including seeing the Notre-Dame Cathedral during the restoration process after the devastating fire in 2019, Arc de Triomphe, Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysees, Place de la Concorde, Luxembourg Palace and Gardens, Latin Quarter, Place de la Bastille, Invalides Hospital, and other Parisian highlights

Evening bateau mouche ride on the River Seine. Observe the gorgeous views of Paris from the River while learning about the history of the area and the famous sites
